



GUAM COMPREHENSIVE CANCER CONTROL (CCC) AWARDS

Application for the 2014 Remi H. Pangan† Spirit of Life Award



Remi Hernandez Pangan† (aka, Zuniga), was an avid businesswoman who served as the Chairperson of the Guam CCC Coalition from June 2009 through June 2010, when her journey with cancer ended. Remi's cancer diagnoses sharpened her commitment to living and focused her energy to work tirelessly on her two devotions: her children and Guam's cancer survivors. In the last years of her life, Remi devoted much of her time to improving the survivorship and quality of life of Guam cancer patients and their caregivers. One of her last projects was co-authoring the Guam Cancer Passport, a booklet designed to help newly diagnosed cancer patients and families navigate through the network of cancer services on Guam. She never gave up.

In celebration of Remi's unwavering spirit, the **Remi H. Pangan† Spirit of Life Award** is presented to a cancer survivor, caregiver, or other individual for his/her encouragement in fighting cancer, dedication to promoting public awareness of cancer survivorship issues and improving the quality of life for cancer survivors, caregivers, and their families.

Nomination and Selection Process

- Anyone from the public is eligible to submit nominations. The nomination form must be signed by the nominator.
- The nominee's contributions or achievements in cancer survivorship and quality of life efforts must be for activities conducted on Guam. Nominees **do not** have to be members of the CCC Coalition. Posthumous nominations are acceptable.
- For the 2014 Awards, eligible activities must have commenced from June 2013 to present. Ongoing activities are acceptable. Activities **do not** have to be endorsed or affiliated with the CCC Coalition to be eligible for nomination.
- Nominations will be reviewed by an anonymous awards committee.
- One award winner will be announced and presented with a commemorative plaque at the 2014 Annual Cancer Retreat on December 12, 2014 (tentative).

Deadline for Submission is at 12:00p.m. on November 14, 2014 (Friday).
