
Examples of progress and success include, but are not limited to: protecting the community from second-hand smoke; implementing education and prevention policies or activities; success in helping tobacco users quit; warning of the dangers of tobacco use and second-hand smoke; enforcing bans on advertising, promotion and sponsorship; and policy or advocacy work that further protects the community from the dangers of tobacco. **Deadline for submission is 4:00 PM on Wednesday, June 15, 2016.**

Award Categories:

- Youth Award: Individual (up to 17 years old)
- Youth Group Award: School/Organization/Team/Youth Group, etc.
- Adult Award
- Community Organization Award: Private/Public Organization, Govt. Agency, Faith Based, etc.
- Legacy Award (Posthumous accepted)

Nominations:

- The nominee's contributions or achievements must be for activities conducted in Guam.
- Ongoing activities are acceptable.
- Nominees do not have to be a member of the NCD Consortium.
- Anyone may submit a nomination – completed and signed nomination forms must be submitted by 4 PM on Wednesday, June 15, 2016.
