GUAM RECEIVES INCREASE IN CANCER GRANTS

The Director of the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) is pleased to announce an increase in grant funding for the Guam Breast & Cervical Cancer Early Detection and Guam Comprehensive Cancer Control Programs. The total grant award for both programs is \$641,357 – an increase of \$85,779.

The Guam Breast & Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program will continue to provide free mammograms and pap smears to eligible women, ages 50 to 64, for the early detection of breast & cervical cancer. The Guam Comprehensive Cancer Control (CCC) Program will continue to support the Guam CCC Coalition in their efforts to implement priority goals and objectives from the 2007-2012 Guam CCC Plan, which includes risk reduction, early detection, better treatment, and enhanced survivorship.
