**DPHSS Providing FREE Adolescent Immunization Outreach Clinic on  
Saturday, April 10 at Micronesia Mall**

*"Vaccinate Before You Graduate"*

The Department of Public Health & Social Services (DPHSS) announces that there will be a Free Adolescent Immunization Outreach Clinic on Saturday, April 10, 2010 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm at the Micronesia Mall (North Wing) below KD toy store. The outreach clinic will be offering free immunizations to graduating students in the 5th grade (11 years of age), 8th and 12th grades.

The goal is to promote the importance of adolescent vaccination and increase Immunization coverage among Guam's adolescent population. Vaccines to be offered are Tetanus, diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap) Meningococcal (MCV4), Human Papillomavirus (HPV) and the 2009 H1N1 vaccine. Parents must bring their child's most current immunization record.

Children under 18 years old must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian or by an adult with written parental authorization or legal documentation and valid photo ID. The outreach clinic will be from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm or while supplies last.
